

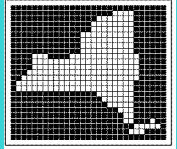

PROPER ACKNOWLEDGMENT

Congratulations on your recent Decentralization grant award. We wish you success with your program, and ask that you publicize the New York State Council on the Arts and Tonawandas' Council on the Arts / Carnegie Art Center support in your own press releases to the local media and via other public relations materials and activities.

Proper Acknowledgment of assistance from the New York State Council on the Arts and Tonawandas' Council on the Arts / Carnegie Art Center is essential to inform the general public that state tax dollars provide local arts programs and services.

As a recipient of Arts Niagara Decentralization funds, you are required to credit the New York State Council on the Arts and Tonawandas' Council on the Arts / Carnegie Art Center as a funding source in all public materials, as stated in #7 of your Cultural Services Agreement:

In any program or printed material advertising, announcing or describing the services for which Decentralization funding has been received, or in any publication, film, videotape, exhibition or visual materials produced as a result of Decentralization funding, the Contractee shall prominently credit the New York State Council on the Arts and Tonawandas' Council on the Arts / Carnegie Art Center assistance. Such credit shall be listed separately from any other recognition of non-governmental support.

In crediting the New York State Council on the Arts and Tonawandas' Council on the Arts / Carnegie Art Center, the following forms may be used:

This event [or performance, exhibition, publication, service, etc.] is made possible with funds from the Arts Niagara Decentralization Program, a regrant program of the New York State Council on the Arts, administered by the Tonawandas' Council on the Arts / Carnegie Art Center.

When the Decentralization regrant funding is not the only source of support, use:

This event [or performance, exhibition, publication, service, etc.] is made possible, in part, with funds from the Arts Niagara Decentralization Program, a regrant program of the New York State Council on the Arts, administered by the Tonawandas' Council on the Arts / Carnegie Art Center.
