Use brushes, sponges and a variety of other items to craft an original painting.

Plastercraft Sculpture 12:00 pm — 1:30 pm

Construct animals, masks and whatever your imagination creates with cardboard, plastercraft and paper.

Printmaking and Painting 10:00 am – 11:30 pm

Learn the basics of printmaking and improve painting skills. Use foam printing plates, paints and ink to create art!

Adventures in Drawing 12:00 pm – 1:30 pm

Improve and polish your drawing skills! Explore different ways to draw your favorite things using a variety of drawing materials.
